
#### **NZ Census data**

- other help or voluntary work for or through any organisation, group or marae none of these



1 in 25 (4.1%) provided unpaid care for someone in their household


1 in 26 (3.9%) provided unpaid care for someone outside their household

- Young carer for people in own HH & outside of HH


1 in 100 provided unpaid care both in & outside of their household


### In 2013, 42,135 young people were providing unpaid care to someone with a disability or illness
